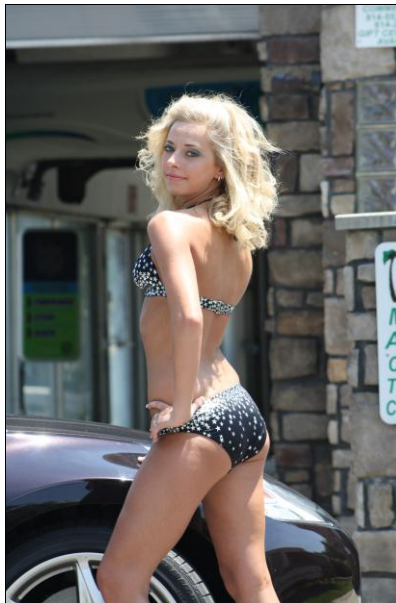
Hello and Welcome...
